



RENTAL RULES AND REGULATIONS WHERE APPLICATION **FOR ALCOHOL SERVICE IS REQUESTED**

THE SERVICE OF ALCOHOL (BEER, WINE AND CHAMPAGNE) ON BARRINGTON PARK DISTRICT PROPERTY IS A PRIVILEGE AND NOT A RIGHT. THE RENTER AND THE RENTER'S INVITEES SHALL BE REQUIRED TO ADHERE TO ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS IMPOSED BY THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE VILLAGE OF BARRINGTON AND THE BARRINGTON PARK DISTRICT REGARDING THE SERVICE OF ALCOHOL. ALL SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.

1. Renters must be **25 years or older** and must supply proof of age.
2. Rentals will not be reserved without an application being fully completed and signed, and without full payment of rental fee, maintenance deposit and any other applicable fees.
3. The application and fees must be submitted a minimum of **sixty (60) days** prior to the event.
4. **Only beer, wine and champagne are permitted to be served. Whenever the term "alcoholic beverage" appears herein, it shall refer only to beer, wine and champagne.**
5. Service of alcoholic beverages is allowed only in the Barrington Room, the Lodge at Citizens Park, and the Jewel Tea Pavilion at Citizens Park, and in a tent which may be set up adjacent to the Pavilion, if prior request and approval have been obtained.
6. Renters must enter into a contract with an approved vendor (list available), and any alcoholic beverages on Park District premises may only be obtained through and served by such approved vendor. Renters and their invitees are prohibited from bringing their own alcohol onto Park District premises.
7. No alcoholic beverages may be sold to guests or invitees; it may only be served to invited guests, 21 years of age or older. ID's will be checked.
8. No alcoholic beverages may be consumed outside of the approved areas of the Barrington Room, the Lodge and the Jewel Tea Pavilion (and tent if applicable) No alcoholic beverages may be served or consumed in any parking lot or within 30 feet of any parking lot.
9. The service of beer, wine and champagne will only be allowed on the date for the specific event and can be served or consumed only in cans, paper cups or plastic glasses.
10. For groups over 125 people where the service of alcohol is requested, the approval of the Director of the Park District is necessary. The maximum number of people at any such event may not exceed 250.
11. For groups over 150 people, the renter will be required to pay for additional police security, which will be arranged through the Barrington Park District, and the fee will be based on the hourly rates charged for such security.
12. The renter and the approved vendor are responsible for securing any necessary license(s) from the State of Illinois and/or the Village of Barrington and proof of such license will be provided to the Park District a minimum of 7 days prior to the event.
13. All events will be monitored by Park District security and personnel and if necessary, the Barrington Police Department. If, in the sole discretion of the Park District Director or agent a determination is made to terminate the event, the renter will abide by the decision and the renter and the renters' guests will leave the Park District premises immediately. Under such circumstances, the renter will be due no refund and the Park District reserves the right to refuse future rentals to the renter.
