

# Middle School Ski Club

## General Information

In cooperation with Station and Prairie Middle School, and St. Anne School, the Barrington Park District will be organizing the 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade ski trips to various ski resorts. The ski trips are held on Friday evenings starting January 15 through February 12, except for two all day ski trips, which are scheduled for Friday, January 22, and Friday, February 11. **To be a member of the BMS Ski Club, all participants must pre-register at the BPD on either 11/19 or 12/2.** Attendance at one of these meetings is **mandatory**. Please read the Registration Information and Procedures carefully.

## Registration Information and Procedures

- You must register on one of the following dates: **THURSDAY, 11/19, OR WEDNESDAY, 12/2.** The informational meeting will start at 7pm. Attendance at the informational meeting is mandatory for all first-time Ski Club participants. Registration will not be accepted before 7:15pm. Registration will be from 7:15-8:15pm. People will be able to register in the order they arrived.
- Registration is at the Barrington Park District, Langendorf Park, 235 Lions Drive.
- Registrations will be taken at any meeting regardless of which grade your child is in or which Middle School your child attends.
- **Bring 2 checks:** one made out to **BMS-PTO** and another check to the **Barrington Park District**.
- **There is a \$25 registration fee per child** (maximum \$75 per family). Each child is required to wear a red neck gator on every trip they attend. **Neck Gators are \$6 each.** These fees need to be paid by check only. Checks need to be made payable to the Barrington Park District.
- **Chaperone Deposit check is \$125** and needs to be made payable to the BMS- PTO. As long as you fulfill your chaperone commitment, your check will be voided and destroyed.
- Please bring a calendar to the meeting; you will be expected to select a chaperone date at the meeting. If you choose not to chaperone, your deposit check will be cashed.
- If you do not attend one of the two registration meetings, registration will only be accepted late at the BPD through December 30, 2009, provided the maximum has not been met. There will be a \$15 late processing fee for all late registrations.
- All sign-ups for individual trips will take place on the Tuesday before the scheduled trip at the Middle Schools during the lunch hour. You will receive a voucher packet at the registration meetings that will have fees on it. These vouchers will need to be turned in with payment on Tuesdays during the lunch hour. There is a \$10 processing fee for signing up for a trip at the BPD, no exceptions.
