Chicago White Sox Training Center

Ages: 5-12 (See below)

Purpose: White Sox Training Centers are a grass roots approach to nurturing a lifelong love for the greatest game on the face of the earth. These are neither day care camps nor autograph sessions. Young players who are interested in improving their skills will be given a chance to learn basic and advanced baseball skills from some of the most gifted teachers in the game.

Instructors: White Sox Training Centers will again be taught by the best in the business; primarily collegiate coaches, ex-professional players, high school coaches, and full-time private instructors. **Each player receives:** 6 Ticket Vouchers to a White Sox game, White Sox Training Center Hat & T-Shirt.



Little Sluggers Camp (5-6 years)

This beginner program is open to boys and girls ages 5 & 6. The purpose of the Little Sluggers program is to introduce this age group to the game of baseball. In addition to focusing on the basics of the game, players will also learn practice leads to improvement and the best way to have more fun playing baseball. Our student to instructor ratio-10:1 or less assures every player of getting the attention they deserve.

White Sox Training Center Camp (STC 1) (7-10 years)

More than 50,000 youth baseball players have attended one of our Training Centers to focus on essential individual aspects of baseball including: throwing, hitting, bunting, fielding, pitching, and base-running. Throughout the week, teachings will be reinforced by using fun skill games. On the final day, all players will get the opportunity to judge their improvement by playing a game. White Sox Travel Player Camp (10-13 years)

If you are a current or aspiring travel player, this camp is for you. Our Travel Player Camp will be conducted similar to a Major League Spring Training practice. Drill concentration will focus on practical use of individual skills within the context of team play. Emphasized will be rundowns, bunt plays, turning double plays, pickoff moves, live stealing, situational pitching and hitting, bunting for a hit, suicide squeezes, advanced infield and outfield play. **Students must be ages 10-13 or have completed STC-1, or be playing for a traveling team.** Student to instructor ratio-10:1 or less.

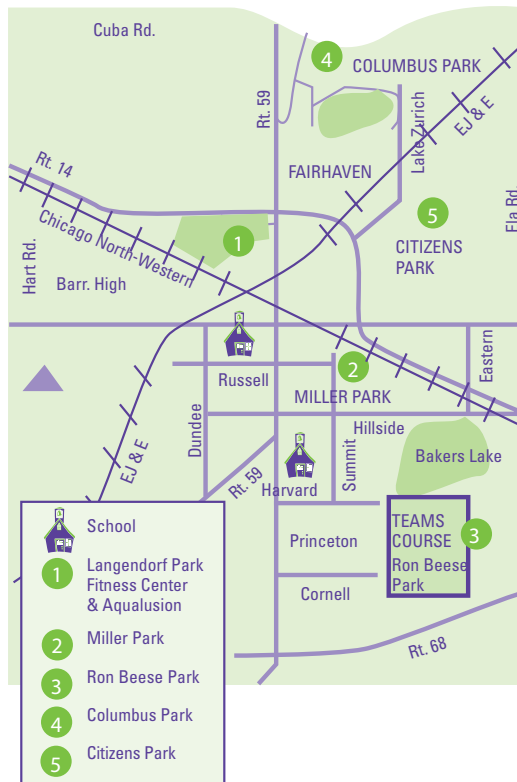

Out-Of-District Annual Membership

The Barrington Park District offers a voluntary, annual membership to any non-resident. Non-residents are those individuals who reside outside the Barrington Park District boundaries.

This membership entitles you to:

- In-District class fees
- A designated early registration period (Dates are listed on the Registration Information page.)

Membership Rules:

- The membership benefits expire one year from date of purchase.
- The membership may only be applied to one pool season.
- If the membership expires during the pool season, the membership must be renewed at the time the pool pass is purchased.
- Any registration made prior to the purchase of the membership will not be retroactive.
