

# Basketball

## Boys' and Girls' League Basketball: Grades 3–8

Players of all skill levels are encouraged to participate in this high-energy travel league for budding hoops players. Whether your child is new to the game or looking to improve basketball skills, this program is the perfect way to have fun playing hoops!

### General Information

Participants are grouped by age — grades 3 & 4, grades 5 & 6, and grades 7 & 8 are combined to create age-appropriate teams of ten players each. Players are evaluated before the start of the season to ensure proper team placement. All games are officiated by certified referees. ### Practice Information

All practices are held during weekday evening at all of the District 220 schools. Coaches for each team determine the location (school), time, and day of the week your child will practice. Players will be required to attend one practice per week in order to qualify for equal playing time on Sundays. Practices will be canceled whenever there is a school closing or school function.

*\*If enrollment is too low for the Girls Basketball League, we will hold a separate girls' clinic or you will receive a full refund for the program.*

### GAME INFORMATION, TIMES, AND REGISTRATION

For each practice and game, players should wear appropriate athletic wear (shorts, T-shirts, and gym shoes). Game jerseys will be provided for each participant. Register at right for the appropriate grade level for your player. All times below are game times; practice times will be determined by each team's coach. Tournament dates will be Sundays, 3/14 and 3/21. If necessary, Saturdays may be used to schedule tournament games. (Min/Max: 40/80).



### League Policies

- Players must pre-register for one of the scheduled player evaluations.
- No request of any kind (carpool, team, or coach) will be accepted. Decisions of the coaches are final.
- Tournament is a two-game guarantee, not a double elimination.
- Coaches for each team will determine practice times for that team. All players must attend one practice per week to be eligible for equal playing time during Sunday games.
- Refunds will only be given in the case of physical impairment or parent job transfer. Refunds are pro-rated from the date of purchase. Proper documentation is required.

- Player evaluations will be the first two weeks of November on Sunday at Prairie Middle School gym.
- Mandatory coaches meeting 11/23 at 7 p.m. in the Barrington Room (Langendorf Park)
- Practice begins 11/30/09.
- Games begin 1/10/10.
- *Tournament dates will be Sunday, 3/14 & 3/21.* If necessary, Saturdays may be used to schedule tournament games.
