Junior Redwings Hockey: Learn to Skate & Scooters

Ages 5-18

Got a budding hockey player? Junior Redwings Hockey is a partnership between the Barrington Park District and the Redwings Hockey Organization. It is the area's premier youth hockey program and is perfect for beginning skaters and those wishing to progress to full team play with Redwings.

Junior Redwings is designed to help young players correctly and appropriately learn developmental skills. Our long-standing program has consistently provided the skill development necessary for young, aspiring hockey players to be able to eventually compete and succeed at competitive levels of youth hockey.

Junior Redwings offers two programs: Learn-to-Skate and

Scooters. Once players progress through these two programs, they are eligible to participate in the full team play with Redwings Youth Hockey.

Learn to Skate starts with the basics of simple balance, then introduce edge work, stride and body position. We finish with controlled turns, hard starts and stops, and backward as well as forward skating. This level does not utilize equipment.

Scooters is the precursor to organized team play. We continue to work on skating skills, but we add hockey sticks, pucks, and full equipment while nurturing a love of the game at all times. We work through the skills of stick handling and passing and shooting. After

developing these fundamentals, we introduce the players to team and game conditions in the Spring Session. Completion of this final session marks the players' "graduation" into Redwings Youth Hockey, with organized, full-season team play the following fall!

What to Wear/Equipment
Participants in Learn to Skate must have ice hockey skates, helmet with facemask, elbow and knee pads, and gloves. (Skates and helmets can be rented at the Ice Arena). Dress

warmly as it is cold in the arena. Participants in Scooters and Redwings Youth Hockey must have a full set of hockey equipment: Ice hockey skates, helmet with facemask, hockey gloves, elbow, shin, and shoulder pads, jock or jill shorts, hockey socks, hockey pants, and a taped hockey stick. A limited number of full sets of equipment are available on loan for the season with a security deposit.

Skateboard Lessons

Ages: 5-13 years

Attention all aspiring Tony Hawks! If you're going to hit the skate park, you want to do it safely. This class, for beginner and intermediate skaters, will help you learn all about skateboarding the right way — the safe way. Beginners will learn how to start, stop and turn, as well as the basics of ramp riding and tricks. Intermediate riders learn skills based on ability. Skaters should bring a drink and must wear a helmet; knee, elbow and wrist guards are strongly encouraged. (Min/Max: 4/10). Instructor: BPD Staff.

Ice Skating

Learn to Figure Skate

Ages 3 years and up

So many young children dream of being a figure skater and twirling on the ice under the spotlight. We can start them on the path with our Learn to Figure Skate program at the Barrington Ice Arena (on Pepper Road just off Rt. 14). Many of our instructors have been coaching skating for over 20 years and were themselves competitive skaters and coaches. They bring a vast background in education, experience, and quality instruction to the ice, helping your child learn to enjoy this beautiful sport.

Equipment & Rentals

Each participant should have figure skates and helmets for Tots and Basic 1-2 classes. Equipment is available for rental at the Barrington Ice Arena. Skate rental is \$3 or eight rentals for \$16 (available on a first-come, first-served basis). Go to www.barringtonicearena.com for more information.

Tot Programs

PARENT/TOT (Ages 3-6 with adult): This class is a wonderful way for parents and children to learn beginning skating skills together. Parents do not have to know how to skate to be enrolled in this class.

TOT 1 (Ages 6 & under without adult): This class is for the beginning skater age 3-6 years. It is designed to make your child's first formal skating experience a fun one.

TOT 2 (Ages 6 & under without adult): This class is for the tot who has successfully completed one semester of Tot 1. More difficult skills are taught, such as gliding on one foot and forward swizzles. Both Tot 1 and Tot 2 are also recommended for our hockey program (see page 46).

ADVANCED TOT (Ages 4-6 without adult): This class helps tots improve their skating skills and have fun doing it. Skaters will learn forward pumps and beginning crossovers, in addition to more difficult skating skills.

PRE-HOCKEY (Ages 3-6 without adult): This partnership between the Barrington Ice Arena and Advanced Power Hockey offers an introduction to skating for ice hockey. Helmet, elbow pads, and skates are required.

Youth Programs

BASIC 1 (Ages 7 & up): Basic 1 is designed for beginning skaters ages 7 and up. It is a perfect way for children to feel more comfortable on their skates for birthday parties and social events (Pre-Alpha).

BASIC 2 (Ages 7 & up): Basic 2 is for skaters who have completed one semester of either Basic 1 or have skated through the Tot 2 program. Skaters will begin such maneuvers as forward pumps and glides (Pre-Alpha).

BASIC 3 (Ages 7 & up): Forward crossovers and backward glides, as well as other fun and more intricate skating maneuvers (Alpha).

BASIC 4 (Ages 7 & up): More intricate backward skating using pumping and edges (Beta).

BASIC 5 (Ages 7 & up): Beginning one-foot spins in this class and beginning toe hop jumps (Beta).

BASIC 6 (Ages 7 & up): Three-turns, hockey stops, and bunny hops (Gamma).

BASIC 7 (Ages 7 & up): Footwork, backward crossovers, and beginning scratch spins (Delta).

BASIC 8 (Ages 7 & up): Waltz jumps from a standstill position and forward inside pivots are some of the exciting skills skaters will learn in this class (Delta).

TEEN/ADULT: This class is designed for teens and adults of all levels.

SYNCHRONIZED SKATING (Ages 7 & up): Synchronized skating is a fun team sport in which 8 to 20 skaters perform a program together in intricate formations.

PRACTICE/BUDDY SKATE: This class provides an opportunity for parents, friends, and siblings to skate with program participants. (Ages 3 yrs. and up; does not include skate rental).
