Eric Anderson of Harris Bank will be invited to a board meeting to give his annual report on financing and funding options. Director Jennings said the board must decide if they want to use non-referendum bonds or go to a referendum to finance park improvements. To have a referendum question on the March 2020 ballot, decisions need to be made by early August 2019 so the question could be prepared and approved by the board in November. Another option would be to put the question on the November 2020 ballot which would allow more time for discussion and preparation.
