## Barrington Park District Ice Rink Rules & Regulations

Welcome. In utilizing the Ice Rink, you acknowledge that you understand and will abide by the following rules and regulations.

## **Ice Rink Hours**

- Monday Friday:
  - Ice Skating 12 pm 7 pm
  - Hockey 10 am 12 pm & 7 pm 9 pm
- > Saturday & Sunday:
  - Ice Skating 12 pm 4 pm
  - Hockey 10 am 12 pm & 4 pm 5:30 pm

Hours are subject to change due to ice conditions, inclement weather, facility closures and holidays.

- Skate at your own risk. Skaters accept the responsibility of knowing the range of their ability while on skates, and skating within the limits of that ability.
- By engaging in skating, skaters are deemed to have knowledge of, and assume the inherent risks of skating.
- Parents are responsible for the supervision and conduct of their children at all times.
- No one is allowed on the ice without ice skates.
- Inspect the Ice Rink before starting play.
- Skating in a manner that endangers or interferes with other skater's safety or pleasure is strictly forbidden.
- Refrain from horseplay. No pushing, shoving or rough play.
- Patrons must not sit on, lean over or place articles on the boards.
- Do not carry anyone, including infants and children, while skating.
- No hockey goals may be brought into the Ice Rink.
- Throwing snow or ice balls is strictly prohibited.
- Profanity, recklessness and fighting are prohibited.
- Use of alcohol, tobacco, e-cigarettes, drugs or weapons is prohibited.
- Climbing the fence and abuse of property are prohibited.
- No trespassing when the Ice Rink is closed.
- No glass, food, drink or pets are allowed in the Ice Rink.
- All Barrington Park District rules and regulations apply.
- Violation of rules and regulations will result in losing skating privileges.
- Barrington Park District is NOT responsible for accidents, injuries, or lost, stolen, or broken items.
- This facility may be closed at any time at the discretion of the Barrington Park District.
