About Us

For over three decades, the BPD Preschool has been built on the understanding that your child's happiness and growth are very important. We offer a play-based program with an emphasis on social, emotional, cognitive, physical and language development. Teachers encourage curiosity and strive to develop a love for learning. Each preschool day has a balanced schedule designed to address all developmental domains important to your child's growth and development. We encourage children to socialize, interact cooperatively and gain independence so they can reach their full potential. With the support of amazing Park District facilities, parks and amenities, there is so much for your child to explore!

Curriculum/Facility

The preschool program includes both group and individual activities throughout the day that are play-based. Meaningful play encourages curiosity, discovery and problem solving. In our classrooms, you will find busy, happy children engaged in math, art, science, language, literacy, dramatic play, music and motor activities. Our school uses the Jolly Phonics© program (also used by School District 220) with all classes to help children learn letter sounds. We follow the Illinois Early Learning Standards and the State of Illinois DCFS guidelines. We offer 3 classrooms, a large motor room, gym and a fenced-in playground dedicated to the preschool program. Our rooms remain securely locked during school hours. Each classroom has a bathroom with a child-size toilet and sink.

Staff

There are two teachers in each classroom with a maximum of sixteen to twenty children based on the class (less for the Mini's class). Teachers work as a team. Every preschool teacher is professionally qualified and dedicated to the education and development of each child enrolled in the program. Teachers keep current in teaching methods through training and attendance at educational seminars throughout the year.

Registration/Fees/Misc.

- HOW TO REGISTER: please visit www.barringtonparkdistrict.org/preschool. You can register online or download a Preschool EFT Registration Form and email it to ksweeney@barringtonparkdistrict.org.
- TUITION: tuition for all classrooms is charged monthly via auto payment on a credit card, starting 9/10/24 5/10/25. Tuition is based on the total number of school days/cost of the program and divided into 9 equal payments.
- REGISTRATION FEE: a \$65 non-refundable registration fee per child is due upon registration. Registration fees are charged per child, per class.
- CALENDAR: the Preschool follows the Barrington School District 220 calendar, starting in September and ending in mid-May. See dates in chart below. There is no class when District 220 is scheduled off.
- All participants must be fully potty-trained and be able to independently use the bathroom before the first day of school. No pull-ups or diapers. Only exception is the Mini's class.

Drop-in programs to extend your child's day. Perfect for parents who sporadically need care!*

Drop-In Lunch Bunch Program End of Class - 12:30pm (Sept. - May)

Perfect for parents who need an extended school day or sporadically need care. Lunch Bunch offers an extra time for lunch and socialization to children enrolled in Preschool. The Preschool is a peanut and tree nut-free zone, and children are required to bring their own lunch.

(Min/Max: 4/16). Instructor: Preschool Teachers.

Fee: \$10.00 per day for 3's, Pre-K (3-day) and Explorers' Enrichment. \$5.00 per day for Pre-K (4-day) .

Drop-In Extended Day End of Class - 2:00pm (Sept. - May)

Extend the preschool day! Includes Lunch Bunch. Enjoy extra time with friends and benefit from the additional amenities the Park District has to offer. Extra enrichment activities such as art, science, gross motor, music and more will be introduced daily. (Min/Max: 4/16). Instructor: Preschool Teachers. Fee: \$25 per day for 3's, Pre-K (3-day) and Explorers' Enrichment. \$20 per day for Pre-K (4-day).

Descriptions

Mini's Classroom

Mini's is a great way to introduce your child to a preschool setting. This class is for the toddler/preschooler who is ready to start exploring on their own. This program includes both group and individual activities that are play-based. Meaningful play encourages curiosity, discovery and problem solving. Classes will follow a weekly theme that will include a circle time, songs, a story, a craft, snack time, socialization and playtime. We will also introduce and sharpen their skills with their letters, numbers, colors and shapes throughout the session. Fine and gross motor skills will be enhanced through games and crafts. Children must be potty-trained, or a parent/ caregiver must be available to change a diaper or pull-up.

3's Classroom

The emphasis in this class is providing children with a wide variety of learning experiences in various domains. It is a play based program with a curriculum that includes hands-on experiences that incorporate the interests of the children. Every day is structured to give each child many opportunities to learn. Students must be fully potty-trained by the first day of class. No pull-ups. If you need additional care you can register for Lunch Bunch which extends the day until 12:30pm or the Extended Day program which extends the day until 2:00pm. If you would like to add a third day of school please check out our Explorer Series that runs on Fridays from 9:00 – 11:30am and also has the option of Lunch Bunch and/or Extended Day.

Afternoon Preschool Sampler

Come join us for an adventure in learning letters, numbers, music, art, science and movement! We will be exploring a new letter and theme every class while gaining classroom functioning and independence skills. If you would like to start your day a littler earlier and get some extra socialization, join us for Lunch Bunch from 11:30am - 12:30pm. We will have a Meet & Greet to meet the teachers and become familiar with the classroom on Thursday, September 14, 2023 from 12:45 - 1:30pm. All participants must be fully potty-trained and be able to independently use the bathroom. No pull-ups or diapers.

Pre-K Classrooms

This class is perfect for children who will be attending kindergarten in the 2023 – 2024 school year and are ready for a three or four day program. The Pre-K curriculum has been developed to meet the specific skills needed to prepare a child for kindergarten. This program includes readiness in reading (Jolly Phonics Program), literature, writing, math, science, social science, art, music, gross and fine motor skills and social/emotional readiness. One of our main goals is to foster children's creativity, originality and imagination. The classroom is a playful and creative environment where children can use their literacy, cognitive and mathematical skills throughout their daily activities. We offer both a 3-day or 4-day programs based on the needs of your student and family. Students must be fully potty-trained by the first day of class. No pull-ups. If you need additional care you can register for Lunch Bunch which extends the day until 12:30pm or the Extended Day program which extends the day until 2:00pm. If you register for the 4-day a week class, but would like 5-days a week then please check out our Explorer Series that runs on Fridays from 9:00 – 11:30am and also has the option of Lunch Bunch and/or Extended Day. It is instructed by the same teachers as the Pre-K 4-day a week class.

Explorer's Enrichment Series

Come join us for a school day that is filled with fun, excitement and lots of enrichment! This mini-series will help your preschooler develop socially and emotionally, grow their fine and gross motor skills and will address all developmental domains important to your child's growth and development. Students will have an exciting new theme each Friday filled with an assortment of academic centers, crafts, S.T.E.M. experiments, movement and music. Each session has fun new weekly themes. This class is perfect if you are in the 3's or Pre-K M-Th program and are looking to add an extra day of school and/or care. Students must be potty-trained. NO DIAPERS OR PULL UPS. by the first day of class. No pull-ups. If you need additional care you can register for Lunch Bunch which extends the day until 12:30pm or the Extended Day program which extends the day until 2:00pm. If you register for the 4-day a week class, but would like 5-days a week then please check out our Explorer Series that runs on Fridays from 9:00 – 11:30am and also has the option of Lunch Bunch and/or Extended Day. It is instructed by the same teachers as the Pre-K 4-day a week class.

Northwest Nature Preschool

AGES: 3 - 4 YEARS OLD BY 1/10/24

Education comes alive in the great outdoors! The Northwest Nature Preschool will be located at Citizens Park with daily hikes in the Cuba Marsh Forest Preserve. Facilitated by a certified preschool teacher in partnership with the Barrington Park District, this cooperative preschool provides a developmentally appropriate, Reggio Emilia-inspired early childhood education that promotes respect for people and nature through outdoor learning. The program offers an ALL-OUTDOOR preschool experience that fosters curiosity, compassion, empathy, cultural awareness, creative problem solving and environmental responsibility in young children. Our goal is to instill respect for people, plants, and animals at an early age, setting the foundation for children to become responsible citizens and environmental stewards. As part of our cooperative, parents are welcomed but not obligated to join our parent-teacher advisory committee or volunteer with the class.

The preschool is instructed and managed by Oak Leaf Cooperative School. Please note this is an OUTDOOR preschool and parents are responsible for providing all outdoor weather-appropriate clothing. In case of severe weather like dangerously low temperatures or lightning, we will utilize the Lodge at Citizens Park for indoor learning. Should there be an onset of heavy snow, class will be held at Langendorf Park that day due to plowing schedules. This will be communicated to parents in advance. **Children must be potty-trained, or a parent/caregiver must be available to change a diaper or pull-up.** (Min/Max: 8/10). Instructor: Oak Leaf Cooperative School Certified Preschool Teacher.

LOCATION: Outside at Citizens Park. If there is severe weather (i.e. if Thor Guard System is activated and/or unsafe conditions arise) we will move inside to the Lodge. Otherwise the program is outside rain, shine or snow.

DAYS: Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays, 1/10/24 - 5/24/24

TIME: 8:30 - 11:30 am

CALENDAR: Oak Leaf Preschool will follow the Barrington School District 220 calendar for days off. There is no school when District 220 is scheduled off. Visit the Park District's website for school calendar in the "Downloads" box at barringtonparkdistrict.org/preschool.

HOW TO REGISTER: Registration opens for all families on 12/1/23 at 9:00am. You can register online (Actv.# 103180) or download an Oak Leaf Preschool EFT Registration Form (barringtonparkdistrict.org/ preschool) and email it to ksweeney@barringtonparkdistrict.org.

TUITION: At the time of registration, \$1,932/\$2,032 will be charged for tuition. A second and final payment of \$502/\$602 will be charged on 1/5/24 via credit card provided at the time of registration. This covers the entire cost of the program January - May 2024.

CANCELLATION POLICY: All cancellation REQUESTS must be submitted in writing by 12/18/23 or you will be charged the program fee in full. Once the school year begins, the only exceptions are medical or moving out of the area (ten mile radius) and documentation must be shown for approval. Possible refund will be based on the number of classes attended and the date the refund request is received.
